Full-scale Mosaic sanctuary replica on display in downtown Atlanta

ATLANTA – History comes alive in Atlanta in the form of a replica of biblical sanctuary built by Moses. Tours are offered June 25 through July 4 from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. The life-sized sanctuary is located across from the Georgia Dome on Northside Drive – right across the street of the location of the 59th Seventh-day Adventist Church World Session.

Messiah's Mansion is a replica of the wilderness Mosaic sanctuary that God directed Moses to build with the Israelites after he led them out of Egypt. The full-scale model includes two fully furnished sanctuaries, accommodates more than 50,000 people and includes visual depictions of Mosaic sanctuary furniture. Everything is to scale and closely simulates what it would have looked like to the children of Israel.

Clayton Leineweber, Messiah's Mansion president, has dedicated his time and effort to seeing this exhibit through. The project is staffed by several high school and college students from around the country and other volunteers that share the passion for the sanctuary message.

In guided tours of the Mosaic sanctuary model, guests see firsthand biblical teaching of salvation through the exhibit of the historical temples of old, the meanings of the symbols throughout the sanctuary and their relevance today. The exhibit is open to the public.

The Mosaic sanctuary was commissioned by God in Exodus 25:8, "And let them make me a sanctuary, that I may dwell among them."

Messiah's Mansion is a non-profit ministry sponsored by the Atlanta North Seventh-day Adventist Church in Dunwoody and Adventist-Layman's Services and Industries.
